Instructions for Poster Presentations

- Each presenter is assigned a unique poster ID number. Your poster should be mounted on the poster board assigned to your ID.
- Posters within themes are assigned to one of three poster sessions. Presenters must be in attendance at their poster during the assigned session. There will be a “**poster tour**” where presenters have the opportunity to give a short introduction to their research (1½ - 2 mins).
- Student presenters should be aware that a **competition** is run by the ESAI throughout the conference judging student posters. The prizes are as follows: ESAI Best Poster at Environ 2010 sponsored by Lifetime Lab, Coford Best Forestry Poster Presentation, Soil Science Society of Ireland Best Soils Presentation, each prize is worth €250 and will be presented at the prizegiving at the end of the conference. Winners will be invited to submit an article on their research project to the Environews bulletin and ESAI website.
- Please do not **remove posters** until the end of the final poster session

Poster Preparation

- Posters should be no larger than A0 (90 by 120 cm) must be portrait in orientation.
- Posters should provide the name of the presenter(s) and their affiliation and contact details
- Posters should include a short description of the research theme and methods used as well as results and the current status of the research as well as expected outcomes/output
- Pictures, photographs and diagrams may be included.
- It can be useful to bring along some A4 printouts of your poster to hand out.

Important Notes for Uploading Poster Abstract:

You will need to upload your abstract (max 300 words) online as a word document when you register.
